LEPPER/FINK/ZWOBODA/SOMBROTTO SCHOLARSHIP

The Vincent R. Sombrotto, Branch 36 announces the 46th annual offering of four (4) college scholarships in honor of Phillip Lepper, Sol Fink, Ron Zwoboda and Vincent R. Sombrotto. Each of the four (4) scholarships will be awarded in the amount of \$2,000.00 paid as annual stipend of \$500.00 per year, maximum of four (4) years.

ELIGIBILITY:

1. Any student who is the son or daughter of a letter carrier, in good standing in Branch 36, either active or retired, may apply if he/she passes the review of school record and examination scores as determined by the Scholarship Committee.
2. The applicant must be a June or January graduate from an accredited secondary school and registered for a degree program at an accredited college or university in September of the same year.

METHOD OF APPLICATION:

1. The member should request a formal application from his/her station shop steward in his/her place of assignment, or member, if retired, should contact Branch 36 Headquarters at 212-239-3901.
2. The student must register for and take the Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT) of the College Entrance Examination Board **NO LATER THAN JANUARY 18, 2019.**
3. The application form and all required documents must be completed and received at Branch 36 Headquarters NO LATER THAN MARCH 22, 2019.
4. The applicant must be sure to include the SAT ENROLLMENT CODE NUMBER for the Lepper/Fink/Zwoboda/Sombrotto Scholarship Fund, which is S.A.T. 0573. Indicate your request to release the SAT scores to the Scholarship Chairman of Branch 36, when registering for the S.A.T. tests.

METHOD OF SELECTION:

The recipients of the awards will be determined by the results of the Scholarship Aptitude Test (SAT) and the three-year school academic record.

The Vincent R. Sombrotto, Branch 36 does not guarantee admission to any college. The applicant is required to make an independent application to the college or university of his/her choice and must meet all requirements for admission.

Payments for Scholarships will be made for tuition only and not for room and board, directly to the Bursar of the college of the winner's selection upon certification of the award winner's registration. Continuance of this Scholarship is dependent upon the award winner's maintaining satisfactory scholarship grades at his/her college during a consecutive four-year period.
